About The Center

The Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health (DMH) Roybal Family Mental Health Center (RFMHC) has served East Los Angeles area families for more than 25 years. It is named after Edward R. Roybal, a 1933 graduate of Roosevelt High School, and UCLA, who helped Hispanics organize politically on local and national levels. Mr. Roybal himself served on the Los Angeles City Council from 1949 to 1962. In 1963, he was the first Hispanic to be elected to the United States Congress since 1879. He served until retirement in 1993. Roybal Family Mental Health Center was part of the Roybal Comprehensive Health Center until moving to its new location in the Centro Estrella Building, in 2002.

Roybal Staff is bilingual in Spanish and English.

Eligibility

Roybal Family Mental Health Center offers assessment and treatment services to children ages 0-18, and their families, who are in need of mental health services. Children eligible for services include those who have been through a traumatic event, and those who exhibit behavioral or emotional symptoms that interfere with their functioning at home and at school. Cal Works adult clients are also eligible for services. Roybal accepts MediCal, some Managed Care, and indigent clients.

- Full Service Partnership for Young Mothers (ages 16-25) and Babies/Toddlers.
- Cal WORKs including individual therapy and groups
