Long Beach API Family Mental Health Center is a public outpatient mental health clinic specialized in serving the Asian Pacific Islander population in LA County. Our multi-disciplinary team provides a full range of services to adults, children, and adolescents, including individual and group psychotherapy, medication support, targeted case management, Full Service Partnership, CalWORKS, evidence-based practices (EBP) including CBT, DBT, IPT, SS, CORS, TF-CBT, FC. We also support clients with their employment, housing, and community re-integration needs. A large percentage of our clients are Cambodian or other Southeast Asian refugees and immigrants who have experienced tremendous trauma and stress before, during, and after migration, and most suffer from depression and PTSD.
