Interdisciplinary psychiatric intake evaluation, Clinical disposition rounds to establish diagnosis & treatment; carry a caseload of 8-10 clients, receive clinical supervision from a Field Instructor who is an PsyD; collaborate treatment with psychiatrist, co-lead a therapeutic group, consult and coordinate Medical Support Services with MD., provide case management services, provide mental health services for individuals, including groups.

Seeking Safety; CBT; DBT; Psychodynamic.
