<b>SAAHAS For Cause – Presentation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two youth from SAAHAS For Cause presented regarding a collaborative project with Taarika Foundation that they are working on where high school aged youth take the lead on creating video content around mental health.</li> <li>• The goals of this project are to raise awareness around mental health, breakdown the discomfort and stigma around mental health struggles for these communities, and empower local youth with tools they need to improve their social-emotional health.</li> </ul>
