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Description of Site: *(Please describe the type of Agency setting and services offered)*

Hollywood Mental Health Center (MHC) is an adult outpatient clinic we serve individuals age 18 and over. While all of our clients have a mental health diagnosis, many would be considered to have severe and persistent mental illness, including psychotic, trauma-related, depressive, bipolar, and co-occurring disorders. Hollywood MHC provides individual and group psychotherapy, case management, crisis intervention, and medication support services. This is an especially exciting time to join our team, as we are in the midst of a groundbreaking innovation in mental health service delivery. The Hollywood Collaborative includes Hollywood. MHC's adult outpatient program, Hollywood MHC's Full-Service Partnership intensive field based program, and the new Hollywood 2.0 field-capable clinical services program. Through the Hollywood Collaborative's 5-year innovation period, we are connecting internal resources and community-facing collaborative partnerships to increase effective engagement with the diverse communities of Hollywood and beyond. If you are drawn to high-quality clinical service delivery, opportunities to use your creativity to promote whole-person mental health care, and integrating systems-level thinking with direct service, this site would be a great fit for you

What specific (perhaps unique) training opportunities do students have at your agency?

Practicum students will conduct biopsychosocial intake assessments, conduct individual psychotherapy, and facilitate clinical triaging and/or crisis intervention, with some exposure to case management skills as indicated. Students will also have the opportunity to facilitate groups.

What evidence based practices or theoretical orientations will students be exposed to at this site?

Students will probably be exposed to Cognitive Behavioral Therapy; Dialectical Behavior Therapy; Acceptance and Commitment Therapy; Recovery- and Strengths-Oriented Approaches; Harm Reduction

Do students have the opportunity to work in a multidisciplinary team environment that includes those with lived experience?

Yes; our team includes psychologists, psychiatrists, nurses, social workers, Marriage and Family Therapists, medical case workers (case managers), community health workers, and administrative staff; many DMH employees have lived experience.
