This training provides participants with an opportunity to take an in-depth look at biases and barriers to engaging fathers, and other adult males, of children and youth involved in the Child Welfare system. Participants will revisit the Integrated Core Practice Model (ICPM) and focus on the Engagement component within the context of the Child and Family Team (CFT) process. Discussions include: defining fatherhood, stereotypes and misconceptions of fatherhood, and fathers' and other adult males' role in the lives of children and youth. Recent data will be shared on the positive impact fathers/males can and do have in the lives of children and youth. The training will explore how a generational shift in cultural norms and perspectives can be a crucial point of engagement for service providers working within systems that historically favor mothers. Strategies to engage fathers and other adult males in their own mental health treatment within the Child and Family Team process will be discussed.
