Spring 2022 – Older Adult Version


The Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health administers surveys over the course of one week once a year to assess how our consumers feel about our services. In Spring 2022, we received 7,255 complete responses. Older Adults had the fewest surveys completed with 613 or 8.4% of all surveys.










93% of Older Adults were very satisfied that staff treated them with respect.








73% of Older Adults were very satisfied that their symptoms were not bothering them as much.
