<u>DMH Updates for the MHC Executive Committee Meeting November 2023</u>

1) MH Commission Referrals Update:

- The Department of Mental Health (DMH) did not receive any constituent referrals from the MH Commission during the month of October.
- 2) Report Response: The following reports were submitted by DMH in September 2023.
 - Bi-Annual Update on Alternative Crisis Response (Item 18, Agenda of September 29, 2020). <u>Link</u>
 - Provides an overview of the Alternative Crisis Response (ACR) data regularly monitored by DMH for 988 calls, ACCESS Crisis Calls, Field Intervention Team (FIT) dispatches and Crisis Stabilization Services;
 - Provides an update on Medi-Cal Mobile Crisis Benefit Implementation:
 - The FITs and Therapeutic Transport Teams will qualify; and
 - The implementation plan is scheduled to be submitted on October 31, 2023;
 - Provides an update on the expansion of FIT, including, but not limited to:
 - Implementation of Mobile Crisis Response Teams (MCOTs) in Service Planning Areas 5, 7, and 8;
 - ACR Hiring Fair efforts (50 hires/conditional offers of various classifications);
 - Additional Crisis Residential Treatment Programs (48 additional beds);
 and
 - Lists future key priorities, including, but not limited to:
 - Lowering response time through FIT expansion;
 - Strengthening law enforcement partnerships (911-988 diversion); and
 - Implement a standardized crisis screener tool.
- **Motions:** In October 2023, the below motions were approved by the Board with reports to be **submitted by** DMH.
 - Proclaiming October 2023 as "Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month" and October 15, 2023, as "Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Day of Remembrance" (Item 20, Agenda of October 3, 2023)
 Purpose: To proclaim October as Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month.
 - Revised Item 22 Updating the County's Implementation of the Proclamation of a Local Emergency for Homelessness in the County of Los Angeles (Revised Item 22, Agenda of October 3, 2023)
 - <u>Purpose:</u> Updates the County's implementation of the Proclamation above by adding a fourth mission, "Eviction Protection"; expediting the lease of properties that support the mission; monthly meetings, monthly verbal updates to the

Board; and various other updates for County departments to provide relevant metrics/outcomes to CEO-HI for reporting purposes.

- Better Reaching the 95% (Revised Item 15, Agenda of October 17, 2023)
 Purpose: To expand DPH-SAPC's R95 Initiative "Reaching the 95%" of individuals with serious substance use disorders who are not engaged in the SUD system.
- Item 66A Implementing Lanterman-Petris-Short Act Reform (Item 66A, Agenda of October 17, 2023)

<u>Purpose:</u> To assess the needs required and the timeline to implement SB43 which reforms the LPS Act.
