The field based services delivered are for children, transitional age youth, adults, and older adults. Job duties include conducting biopsychosocial assessments, formulating treatment plans, applying psychotherapeutic methods, providing intensive case management, crisis interventions, and collaborating with an interdisciplinary team to provide adjunctive support services or conduct groups. There are two office locations for various programs: Cerritos (Recovery, Resilience and Reintegration, Prevention and Early Inregretation, and Specialized Foster Care) Hollywood (Full Service Partnership).
