Roybal Family Mental Health Center is a directly operated children's clinic serving children ages 0-18. Roybal offers assessments, individual therapy, dyadic therapy, family therapy, group therapy, psychiatric services, medication support and case management services to children ages 0-18, and their families, who are in need of mental health services. Children eligible for services include those who have been through a traumatic event, and those who exhibit behavioral or emotional symptoms that interfere with their functioning at home and at school.
