WVMHC provides a variety of mental health services, which include assessments, establishing diagnoses/exploring differential diagnoses, treatment plan development, individual and group therapy services, case management, crisis intervention/safety assessments, medication support, recreational therapy, occupational rehab, peer support and substance abuse counseling. Services are provided in-person or through telehealth. The FSP program provides field-based mental health services for adults who are experiencing homelessness, frequent psychiatric hospitalizations, and/or involvement with the criminal justice system due to symptoms of a severe mental illness.
