Executive Committee Election Process FY2024-2025

Commission Annual Election of Officers (See Bylaws, page 8)

The Los Angeles County Mental Health Commission votes on a new slate of officers for the Executive Committee every June. Nominations Committee will open the process in April and present a slate at the May general meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor, but you are encouraged to apply prior to that time. Voting will occur at the general meeting in June.

The Commission shall elect the following to serve one year from date of election or until their successors have been duly elected:

- a. Chairperson
- b. First Vice Chairperson
- c. Second Vice Chairperson
- d. Members-At-Large

Election Timeline

March

Chairperson will distribute an "<u>Interest Survey</u>" to determine if Commissioners are willing to serve on the Nomination Committee. Survey will include statement that nominations will be accepted from the floor in June.

April

At the Executive Committee meeting, the Chairperson shall appoint the Nomination Committee and report at the following regular meeting of the full Commission; and, the Commission shall ratify the Nomination Committee at that meeting. The Nomination Committee will be composed of no less than two Commission members.

May

The Nomination Committee shall make a report of its recommendations for each Officer position and the Members-At-Large. At the same meeting, further nominations will be accepted from the floor.

June

The Commission shall vote on the Officer positions and the Members-At- Large in accordance with the Brown Act.

July

The Officers and Members At-Large elected at the June meeting will take their respective offices on July 1st.
