PURPOSE/GOALS/OBJECTIVES AD HOC WILL CONTRIBUTE TOWARD (5604.2)

1. "Ensure community involvement at all stages of the process leading to the formation and adoption of the County alcohol and drug program plans," per California WIC 5604.2

AD HOC PLAN:

- 1.
