### Hollywood Respite and Recovery Center

An innovative model that provides person-centered mental health crisis response services as an alternative to a hospital emergency room. The center will have an urgent care center (UCC) and enhanced peer respite available in one location.

- Peer Respite a 24/7 voluntary, short-term, overnight program that provides communitybased, non-clinical crisis support to help people find new understanding and ways to move forward.
- Urgent Care Center one-stop, same-day, outpatient mental health services, as well as short-term crisis stabilization services.

#### **Employment**

Employment services to assist people living with mental health conditions to enter or re-enter the workforce in Hollywood.

#### **Board and Care**

Residential settings that provide room and board, 24-hour staffing, and assistance with daily activities such as bathing, dressing, medication management, and psycho-social rehab.

#### Clubhouse

A community-based center designed to support recovery for people living with serious mental illness. Provides a restorative environment for people living with serious mental illness to discover and invest in their sense of self, purpose, and community.

#### Interim Housing

Low barrier temporary housing and services for people with mental illness who are homeless and lack income to pay for temporary housing. Provides safe and clean shelter, 24-hour general oversight, three meals a day, linens, clothing, toiletries, and case management services to assist clients with transitioning to permanent housing.

#### **Local Community Events/Meetings**

Local events and meetings to learn about Hollywood 2.0, provide feedback, and get involved.

## Hollywood Mental Health Cooperative Clinic

DMH's community-based clinic located in Hollywood. Services include assessment, therapy, medication, case management/brokerage, crisis intervention, and other supportive services related to housing and employment for those with serious mental illness. Services are provided in the clinic and the field.
