#### TRAUMA INFORMED DE-ESCALATION

This 3-hr course will address strategies for working with escalated individuals in a way that builds empathy, understanding and a trauma-informed approach. This course will define trauma, empathy, and crisis development and the precipitating factors that lead to escalated incidents. The goals of de-escalation, including intervention skills: verbal, non-verbal, active listening and strategies are explained with emphasis on how to engage with another person in a way to help them feel heard and understood. Ways to mitigate and prevent an escalation from rising, debrief, and follow-up care are included in the discussion. A mindfulness activity and focus on self-care to prevent burnout are highlighted.
