Spring 2023 – Families Version


The Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health administers surveys over the course of one week once a year to assess how our consumers feel about our services. In Spring 2023, we received **9,545** complete responses. Families completed **3,213** surveys or **33.7%** of all responses.



98% of Families were very satisfied that staff respected their religious or spiritual beliefs.



91% of Families were very satisfied that their child is better able to cope when things go wrong.



Most family survey participants were Latinx, which reflects the demographics of Los Angeles County.






98% of Families were very satisfied that staff treated them with respect.





90% of Families were very satisfied with their child doing better in school or work.



Most family surveys were completed in **English** or **Spanish** with a smaller number in **Cambodian and Korean.**
