




Population by Age Group






Age Group Distribution among Los Angeles County's Medi-Cal Eligibles



Top 3 Primary Languages




Race/Ethnicity Distribution among Los Angeles County's Medi-Cal Eligibles















CSS Unique Clients Served by Service Area



Prevention and Early Intervention: Early Intervention: Early Intervention



UNIQUE CLIENTS SERVED BY FISCAL YEAR




MHSA Clients Served Over Time

PEI Unique Clients Served by Service Area








Los Angeles homeless point-in-time estimate declined slightly-down **0.27%** in Los Angeles County and **2.2%** in the City of Los Angeles.




Three-Year Trend for Sheltered¹ versus Unsheltered¹ Individuals Experiencing Homelessness






