REQUIRED MONTHLY REPORTING, PURSUANT TO THE NOVEMBER 29, 2023 JUDGMENT OF THE KATIE A. LAWSUIT, REGARDING THE DCFS "TA280" REQUESTS FOR OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT STOP OR CHANGE REPORT

On November 29, 2023, the United States District Court for the Central District of California entered a judgment ending the Katie A. lawsuit; however, the judgement requires ongoing publishing of information from the County of Los Angeles for a period of 18 months.

The attached report from August 2024, serves as the tenth monthly publishing of the County of Los Angeles Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) "TA280" reports. The "TA280" report shows a summary table of the requests made by DCFS staff for out-of-home placements to be stopped or changed.
