Primary services provided include crisis intervention and evaluation. Additional services provided to community members include collaboration with local schools, law enforcement agencies, and community agency (DCFS, APS, DHS, DPSS), disaster response and debriefing, psycho-education with family, consultation with non-mental health professionals, mental health service linkage and referral, homeless outreach and engagement.
