Additional services provided to community members include collaboration with local schools, law enforcement agencies, and community agency (DCFS, APS, DHS, DPSS), disaster response and debriefing, psycho-education with family, consultation with non-mental health professionals, mental health service linkage and referral, homeless outreach and engagement.
