We are co-located within the DCFS office building in SA4. We are a directly operated LAC-DMH site, that focuses on providing assessment, individual therapy, and case management services to children and families involved in the DCFS system. Our clients range from 0-21 years old, with opportunity for individual therapy and family therapy. We primarily provide services in the field and office settings, with the ability to also see children in the schools or shelter settings. We work closely with our DCFS partners to meet the needs of the client. We attend case consultations and Child/Family Team meetings as requested. Many of our clients come from diverse backgrounds and we strive to provide culturally sensitive services. We offer supervision in Spanish as well, to further foster Spanish speaking therapeutic skills.
