The current position is for the mental health CSEC (Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children) program within DMH countywide. The CSEC program is a field position working as part of a multi-disciplinary team on a regular basis to provide and link trauma –informed mental health services and best practices to youth who are at risk or have been sexually exploited. Qualified applicant is expected to be able to collaborate, consult, and assists members of the MDT, Child Trafficking Unit (CTU) Deputy Probation Officers (DPOs) with referral, linkage, and support of mental health services, attend court hearings, provide information, education, and assistance with relevant resources for youth and families regarding mental health services. This position will require applicant to be field-based with interviews and visits conducted in the juvenile hall/camps, and/or client's place of residence, including but not limited to group homes/foster homes.
