Hollywood Mental Health Center (MHC) is an adult outpatient clinic we serve individuals age 18 and over. While all of our clients have a mental health diagnosis, many would be considered. to have severe and persistent mental illness, including psychotic, trauma-related, depressive, bipolar, and co-occurring disorders. Hollywood MHC provides individual and group. psychotherapy, case management, crisis intervention, and medication support services. This is an especially exciting time to join our team, as we are in the midst of a groundbreaking. innovation in mental health service delivery. The Hollywood Collaborative includes Hollywood.

MHC's adult outpatient program, Hollywood MHC's Full-Service Partnership intensive field based program, and the new Hollywood 2.0 field-capable clinical services program.
