The Rio Hondo Mental Health Center is an adult outpatient mental health program that provides PEI, FSP, CalWORKS, and OCS level of care. Services include individual, group therapy, medication management, case management, substance abuse counseling, employment, housing assistance, legal aid, and more. The adult Full-Service Partnership program is a field-based program that helps clients considered to be underserved or unserved, to receive specialty mental health service. The program provides these services as a team. Clients meet with staff two times a week, or more, depending on the level of need. FSP focuses on crisis intervention, stabilization and transitioning clients to a lower level of care within a 1-2 year timeframe.
