**Description of Site:** (Please describe the type of Agency setting and services offered)

Long Beach Mental Health (LBMH) is one of the largest outpatient community mental health centers operated by Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health. Its mission is to provide mental healthcare to adults (i.e., 18 and older) who struggle with a range of mild-to-severe mental health conditions. Our patients are quite diverse with respect to their racial, cultural, gender and sexual identities and socioeconomic backgrounds. Services are provided in English and Spanish, and include clinical assessment, individual and group therapy, psychotropic medication management, crisis intervention, case management and consultation-liaison services with community partners.

What specific (perhaps unique) training opportunities do students have at your agency?

Students will gain valuable instruction in evidence-based treatment models through supervision consistent with the theoretical models being delivered (e.g., CBT/DBT). Students will also have opportunities to provide psychodiagnostics assessment, attending numerous seminars/trainings, learn group therapy by co-facilitating, and have their own caseloads.

What evidence based practices or theoretical orientations will students be exposed to at this site? CBT and third-wave cognitive behavioral approaches (DBT, ACT, Mindfulness-Based Cognitive Therapy), and Motivational Interviewing.

Do students have the opportunity to work in a multidisciplinary team environment that includes those with lived experience?

LBMH's clinic staff are multidisciplinary, including Psychologists, Psychiatrists, Clinical Social Workers, Medical Caseworkers, and Service Extenders/peer specialists.
