DESCRIPTION: The TGI Cultural Transformation Training Series is designed to educate service providers about transgender, gender expansive, and intersex (TGI) communities. Through the many topics that are covered, our goal is to equip participants with education and tools to be agents of transformation so that they may create a culture that sees, values, and affirms the experiences of TGI people.

1. Create a foundational understanding about the difference between sex, gender, and sexuality by unpacking language and exploring dominant societal expectations.
2. Utilize sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression (SOGIE) as a framework for understanding disproportionate impact and implementing inclusive practices.
3. Develop an awareness of implicit bias, stigma, intersectionality, and psychosocial considerations.
4. Learn about gender exploration, transition, and your role in gender-affirming mental health and care.
