# WHAT IS CBEST?

#### THE COUNTYWIDE BENEFITS ENTITLEMENT SERVICES TEAM

is a Los Angeles Health Services program with teams made up of benefits advocates, clinicians, and legal partners that help people apply for disability income programs:

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI)

# **CBEST SCOPE OF SERVICES**

- Connect people to case management & housing resources.
- · Gather health records and outline medical history
- Finish and turn in disability benefits applications
- Full scope legal services for appeals and post-award suspensions and terminations.
