


Priority Goal #5  
**Removal of Children from Home**  
Goal for Reduction 

Removal of children from home, specifically those with an open child welfare status, refers to when children may be removed from their home due to abuse and/or neglect. Providing early intervention and intensive BH services to parents and additional members of the family unit living with a behavioral health condition can prevent family disruption and improve child welfare outcomes.


Point in Time/In Care Counts of the children in foster care including all children who have an open child welfare or probation supervised placement episode in the system. (April)


Point in Time/In Care Counts of the children in foster care including all children who have an open child welfare or probation supervised placement episode in the system. April 2025, Los Angeles County

Disparity in Point in Time/In Care Counts of children in foster care including all children who have an open child welfare or probation supervised placement episode in the system.



# Untreated Behavioral Health Conditions

Goal for Reduction 

An individual's behavioral health condition that has not been diagnosed or attended to with appropriate and timely care.

# Untreated Behavioral Health Conditions

The percentage of emergency department (ED) visits among members age 13 years and older with a principal diagnosis of substance use disorder (SUD), or any diagnosis of drug overdose, for which there was follow-up within 30 days of the ED visit (31 total days). (FUA-30) This measure should be analyzed alongside Follow-up after Emergency Department Visit for Substance Use.

The percentage of emergency department (ED) visits for members 6 years of age and older with a principal diagnosis of mental illness, or any diagnosis of intentional self-harm, and had a mental health follow-up service within 30 days of the ED visit (31 total days). (FUM-30). This measure should be analyzed alongside Follow-up after Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness.
