


About SAPC

Recovery Bridge Housing

Recovery-oriented, peer supportive interim housing that provides a safe living environment for patients who are homeless or unstably housed **while receiving outpatient SUD treatment.**

- ☑ **As long as 360 days**

Recovery Housing

This is a **NEW** option which began in April 2025. It is the same as RBH except:

- ☑ **Will not require concurrent enrollment in outpatient SUD treatment,** but requires a recent history of treatment within the last 90 days with SAPC
