- 3. Identify interventions that are a last resort, reasonable, and proportionate to the risk presented.
- 4. Describe how to consider the risks of restraints and the opt-out sequence when using the CPI holding principles.
- 5. Apply a framework that helps guide staff through the process of establishing therapeutic rapport and learning after a crisis.
