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Description of Site: *(Please describe the type of Agency setting and services offered)*

Northeast Mental Health Center is an adult outpatient mental health center serving individuals who present with severe, persistent mental illness. Services include medication support, individual and group psychotherapy, rehabilitation, and targeted case management services. Clients typically present multiple problem areas including poverty, homelessness, substance use disorders, trauma history, need for ongoing support. In this advanced practicum, students will obtain individual psychotherapy experience, intake assessment and diagnosing experience, and participate in multi-disciplinary team consultations. Candidates will train and gain practice experience in Psychological Assessment including cognitive testing, personality testing, and some Neurocognitive testing including attention-deficit assessment.
