

The Basics of Housing Navigation – How to Successfully Prepare Your Tenants for & Assist Them with the Housing Search

DESCRIPTION: This training, designed for case management level housing staff, will address how to provide quality supportive housing services to individuals who are experiencing homelessness or are at risk of homelessness. Participants will learn about the types of housing available to consumers, eligibility criteria for the various types of housing, and how to obtain required documentation. Training participants will learn housing search fundamentals as well as be prepared to assist their consumers with better ways to search for housing.

OBJECTIVES: As a result of attending this training, participants should be able to:

1. Describe three (3) types of housing that are available to their consumers.
2. Assist consumers with each stage of the housing search process.
3. Identify available affordable & interim housing resources.
4. Describe housing search fundamentals and how to best prepare consumers for searching housing resources.
5. Identify (3) self-advocacy skills consumers can utilize to improve securing and maintaining housing.
