Community Outpatient Mental Health Clinic primarily serves people who qualify for Medi-Cal insurance due to low income. We receive referrals from various community agencies and hospitals. We complete screening and if person needs specialty mental health, they are scheduled for intake/assessment. Full scope Medi-Cal services are provided in a team setting. Social work interns would provide screening, assessment and psychotherapy. Additional services by treatment team include medication support, substance abuse treatment, and case management to provide assistance with housing, benefits establishment and linkage to community resources.
