

Department of Mental Health (DMH) Updates for the Behavioral Health Commission (BHC) Executive Committee Meeting (February 26, 2026)

Report Response: The following reports were submitted by DMH in January 2026.

- **Quarterly Update on Initiating the Hollywood 2.0 (H2O) Pilot Project (Item 6, Agenda of November 2, 2021) ([Link](#))**
 - The report provides a description of:
 - Status of the evaluation components and results as they develop.
 - 27 data collection visits to H2O sites and 35 comparison sites were conducted this quarter.
 - 544 surveys completed (256 from H2O clients and 288 from comparison site clients).
 - Status of trainings and partnerships in Trieste, New York, Fountain House and others.
 - Community engagement and outreach strategies.
 - Opened the new Hollywood Mental Health Cooperative (HMH Co-Op)
 - Launched the new [H2O Volunteer and Donation Portal](#)
 - Services offered: outpatient and field-based treatment, housing supports, and opportunities for meaning/purpose and connection
 - Housing: H2O's interim housing sites continue to operate at full capacity.
 - Hollywood Mental Health Cooperative (HMH Co-Op) programs overall have served 6,721 clients. The HMH Co-Op field teams are currently serving 397 active clients.
 - It also includes a list of services offered for the various components of the pilot.
- **Annual Report to the Board for Expanding Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) and Probate Conservatorship Capacity in LA County (Item 9, Agenda of August 8, 2017) ([Link](#))**
 - This is the annual report from the Office of Public Guardian (OPG) providing annual reports to the Board on conservatorships. It includes data for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025.
 - Highlights:
 - Number of OPG clients placed in conservatorship: Probate-68; Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS)-425 new and 1,421 reappointed.
 - Referrals Accepted and Investigated: 100% Probate (1,435) and 99% LPS (~1,170).
 - 11,322 OPG client visits conducted in FY 2024-2025.
 - 712 LPS conservatorships were terminated in the reporting period.

- Additional data includes information regarding OPG clients in locked facilities, average length of stays, number of clients waiting for a higher levels of care.
