DESCRIPTION: The TGI Cultural Transformation Training Series is designed to educate service providers about transgender, gender expansive, and intersex (TGI) communities. We recognize that inclusivity takes a cultural shift as many social services and programs are or were created without TGI people in mind. Through the many topics that are covered, our goal is to equip participants with education and tools to be agents of transformation so that they may create a culture that sees, values, and affirms the experiences of TGI people. This additional session is offered to enhance the staff's understanding and expand on the information previously presented. As a result, this technical assistance/booster will be aimed towards staff who have previously attended the 3-hour TGI Cultural Transformation Training. The material will cover a review and offer attendees a Q & A discussion with the trainer.

3. Identify bias and stigma, while also identifying practical strategies for fostering inclusive environments.
4. Explain how to incorporate gender-affirming practices into clinical work, including using gender-affirming language, providing resources, and supporting individuals during gender exploration or transition.
