

Underlying Needs: A Strengths/Needs-Based Service Crafting Approach

DESCRIPTION: This training will increase participants' knowledge about underlying needs and how underlying needs are behind behaviors. Participants will recognize that focusing on children's behaviors obscures the needs behind the behavior and that trying to change the behavior without addressing the needs behind it is unlikely to be successful. The training will include describing the criteria for a strong needs statement, the importance of supporting the team to reach an agreement about the child's needs, and an opportunity to practice writing strong needs statements. In addition, participants will have the opportunity to explore how they can incorporate the family's culture, strengths and needs to develop tailored services and supports that are unique for each child and family.

TARGET AUDIENCE: **DMH staff and contracted mental health providers rendering services to children/youth in the child welfare system and/or in the community.**

OBJECTIVES:

As a result of attending this training, participants should be able to:

1. List at least two strength-based approaches when engaging children, youth and families.
2. Describe underlying needs and how these needs manifest in children and youth as behaviors.
3. Describe how the child and family's culture, strengths, and underlying needs are used to develop individualized treatment plans.
4. Prepare individualized treatment plans incorporating services and supports to meet the child or youth's needs.
