

- (3) For cities that have small portions of adjacent unincorporated areas, the city name will be followed by the label "UI" and the name of the unincorporated area, e.g., Lynwood-UI Lynwood. In these instances, the annual allocation for that Study Area is given to the city.
- (4) The Study Areas accumulate all or a portion of the available fund balance to cover the cost of future projects.
