

**Los Angeles County FY 2026-27 Measure A Spending Plan  
Public Meetings Timeline**

This timeline represents the Department of Homeless Services and Housing's (HSH) good faith effort to provide transparency and collaboration during the FY 2026-27 Measure A Spending Plan process. The dates in this document also consider HSH's commitment to:

- execute contracts by July 1, 2026, for timely payment and to prevent gaps in services and funding;
- give administrators and homeless service providers sufficient time to scale down programs that may be reducing in size or ending, including providing ample notice to contract holders and staff per existing agreement terms or legal requirements; and,
- to meet the required timelines of Los Angeles County's budget process to ensure that HSH has the authority to spend funds and execute agreements.

**\*Draft Spending Plan:**

The draft Spending Plan includes the proposed line-by-line programmatic allocations for programs and services within the Comprehensive Homelessness Services, Homelessness Solutions Innovations, and Accountability, Data and Research funding buckets. **\*\*Draft Board Letter:**

The draft Board Letter includes the Board of Supervisors action items and the proposed Spending Plan which will have incorporated feedback on the spending plan that was provided during the public comment period. It provides visibility as to how feedback was addressed before the recommendations go to the Board. Several procedural steps must occur to ensure the item is agendaized for consideration by the Board of Supervisors between the time the draft board letter is finalized in December and when they consider it at its public meeting in January.

**Note:** *The table above includes proposed public engagement of the Homeless Policy Deputies, the Executive Committee for Regional Homeless Alignment (ECRHA), the Leadership Table for Regional Homeless Alignment (LTRHA), the Measure A Labor Council, and large community engagement sessions. Additional engagement is being conducted with people with lived expertise, service providers, local jurisdictions, County departments, Board offices, and other system leaders. In addition to the public presentations above, the County is partnering with the LTRHA through engagement with the System Improvement & Accountability (SIA) Subcommittee.*
