Program Update

Reduction in ICMS funding in FY26/27

- Curtailment of PreMatch ICMS
- Programmatic efficiencies
- Fewer projected federal housing vouchers

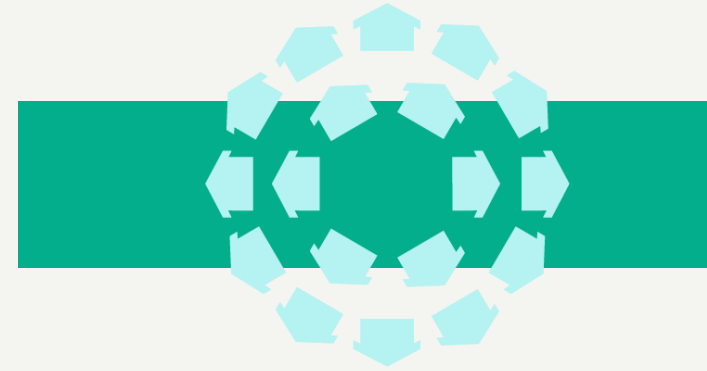
System Priorities

- We are prioritizing funding for interim and permanent housing programs
- Preserving nearly all County housing resources
 - HSH will continue to fund PSH
 - Maintaining housing for families, youth, and survivors of gender-based violence

**Program focus is now on:
Transitioning all active clients to appropriate next steps**

Important Timeline:

- **February 10, 2026**
 - PreMatch enrollments closed
- **April 2026**
 - All vacant slots to be closed
 - All clients with current dual enrollments to be exited
- **May 31, 2026**
 - All clients exited from PreMatch
- **June 2026**
HSH Administrative Close Out Process
- **July 1, 2026**
Program fully ends



Rampdown Activities

- Continue ongoing monthly check-ins with your HSH PreMatch Program Manager
- Your primary focus is program transitions and referrals for clients actively on your caseloads
- Referrals to programs that will continue to CES Connected Programs:
 - Outreach
 - Interim Housing
- Clear documentation is required for every client
 - Warm Handoff to the referring program
 - Exits require a close out note in CHAMP by Case Manager
 - HSH PreMatch Program Manager will review and approve exits

Referral to CES Connected Programs

Interim Housing

- If client has high medical and/or clinical needs and supports:
 - Submit referral via CHAMP
- All other clients:
 - Submit referral via HMIS

Outreach

- If client refuses IH referral:
 - Update PreMatch Tracker to reflect the following:
 - SPA currently experiencing homelessness
 - Cross streets for current location
 - Contact information for this client
