

Ride Free on Transit Equity Day



Transit Equity Day is Sunday, Feb. 4. Set on Rosa Parks' birthday, it's a day that promotes making transit affordable and accessible to people in all communities.

Metrolink will honor Transit Equity Day by offering free rides on trains throughout Southern California. Just arrive at the station and board the train (no ticket is required).

Rides are also free on Metro Bus, Rail and Bike Share, OC Bus, and all San Bernardino County transit providers.

Ventura County transit providers will celebrate Transit Equity Day the following day, Feb. 5, with free rides.

How to Use the 405 Express Toll Lanes



In order to ride in the new time saving 405 Express Lanes—which run between SR-73 in Costa Mesa and I-605 at the border of

LA County—a vehicle must be equipped with a FasTrak transponder set to the correct occupancy of the vehicle.

Solo drivers can access the lanes for a toll. Three-person carpools ride free at all times, two-person carpools during non-peak hours.

Motorists can get help signing up for a transponder, setting up an account and learning about tolls and carpool rules at 405expresslanes.com.

Metro Adds More Frequent Bus and Rail Service

Metro last month added more frequent light rail service on the A, C, E and K lines as part of its program of twice-yearly service changes. It also added ore late-night trains on the A and E lines.
