Gear Up for Bike Month



May is National Bike Month, and your Southern California transportation agencies have plenty in store to help you discover the joys of commuting by bike—including e-bikes.

Here's what's happening...

Throughout Southern California

Cyclists can ride **Metrolink** for free on Bike Day, Thursday, May 15, when they bring their bike on board.

Bikes are allowed on all trains, and Metrolink features special **Bike Cars** designed to accommodate more bikes.

In Los Angeles County

Bike commuters will have plenty to smile about with free rides, prizes, discounts and special promotions.



Ride Free: Rides are free on Bike Day, Thursday, May 15, on Metro Bus and Rail, **Metro Bike Share** (30-minute rides) and **Metro Micro**.

Win Prizes: Track your bike commute trips on ridematch.info all month long to qualify for prizes, including an e-bike, commuter and road bikes, a folding bike, cycling gear and more.

Each bike trip logged counts as a raffle entry. The more you ride, the better your chances to win.

Discounts: During May, get a 30-Day **Bike Share** pass for just \$1, and during Bike Week (May 11-17), 365-Day passes are half price. **BikeLink locker stations** will also be offering special discounts.

In Orange County

Win Prizes: **Pledge to bike** one or more times in May, and you could win an e-bike package that includes an Avant Agile Commuter E-Bike, helmets, a bike lock and baby seat.

Bike Rally: Join Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) for a bike rally on May 28 (new date), 7:30 – 9 a.m., at the Orange Metrolink Station. Attendees will receive a free t-shirt (while supplies last) and be entered to win prizes available to

bike rally participants only. Then join other cyclists on a 3-mile ride to OCTA Headquarters in Orange.

In Riverside/San Bernardino Counties
