- Domestic Violence Survivors/Batterers/Anger Management
- Parents navigating child welfare (DCFS)
- Justice-involved individuals and families
- Women working toward reunification with their children

### Overview of Services

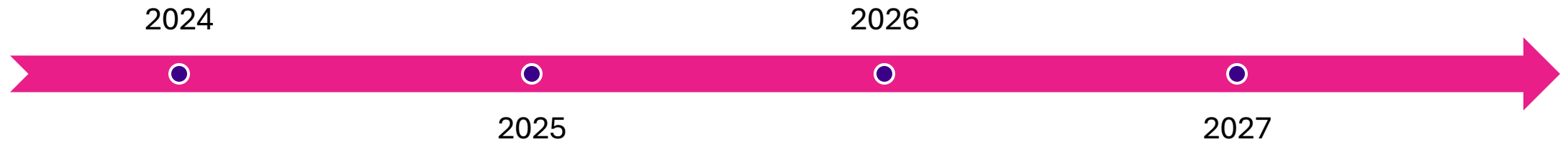
Trauma-informed, culturally responsive support:

- SheNavigators – system navigation & reunification support
- **IMPACT™ – court-approved DV program**
- Parenting & high-conflict parenting classes
- Emotional healing, accountability, and life skills

# Funding Overview & Spenddown Status

## Funding actively utilized | Direct services & staffing



Timeline: 2024 – 2026

### Funding Allocation Breakdown

#### Funding supports:

- Direct services (groups, case management, navigation, stipends, transportation, housing and food )
- Staffing (facilitators, care managers, peer-mentors)
- Program operations & community engagement

### Spenddown Status

- Funds are actively being utilized and increasing as engagement grows
- Majority allocated toward direct services and staffing, peer mentors
- *Note: Initial ramp-up required time to build community trust—now fully active and expanding reach.*

# Impact & Outcomes

## Who & Where We Serve

### People Served:

- 25+ women per cohort
- Dozens of families impacted through extended services

### Where We Serve:

- 95 % Antelope Valley (Palmdale, Lancaster)
- SPA 1 communities is our target, however we have people from the city of Los Angeles to the AV

## Key Outcomes & System Impact

### Outcomes Achieved:

- Increased awareness of healthy relationships and violence prevention
- Improved communication and emotional regulation
- Mothers progressing toward family reunification
- Stronger engagement with DCFS and court systems
- **Expanded System Impact:**
- VIP status with LA County Probation for Domestic Violence
- **IMPACT is now court-approved across LA County**

# Gaps & Challenges

## Programmatic Challenges

- Time needed to build trust with high-risk populations
- Clients balancing work, court, and parenting responsibilities
- Staffing capacity as demand increases
- Emotional readiness of participants

## System & Sustainability

- Uncertainty around funding beyond February 2026
- Delays in referrals from partner systems
- Complex system requirements across DCFS & Probation
- Risks to long-term sustainability of services
- ***Real Talk: We are doing impactful work—sustainability is our biggest concern.***

# Opportunities & Next Steps

## What's Working & Opportunities

### **What's Working:**

- Strong DCFS partnership; new Probation Department partnership
- Culturally responsive, trust-based approach and lived experience.
- High engagement and potential to become Peer Mentors

### **Opportunities:**

- Increase staffing to meet demand without the fear of financial cuts .
- Strengthen relationships with other community services.

## Next Steps & What We Need

### **Next Steps:**

- Scale services across child welfare & probation systems
- Continue building cross-system collaboration
- Execute long-term sustainability plan to ensure longevity

### **What We Need:**

- Continued funding beyond June 2027
- Investment in programs create safety in the community for everyone
- Housing funding for permanency
