MARCH 7, 2016

1. Call to Order.

This meeting of the County of Los Angeles Claims Board was called to order at 9:30 a.m. The meeting was held in the Executive Conference Room, 648 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California.

a. <u>Adrian Scott Morgan v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> United States District Court Case No. CV 08-8357-ODW

> This lawsuit alleges deliberate indifference to an inmate's medical needs while he was incarcerated at Men's Central Jail.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$175,000.

b. <u>Desiree Henriquez, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> United States District Court Case No. 2:14-CV00196-GW

This wrongful death lawsuit arises from the death of an accident victim that was treated by Los Angeles County Fire Department paramedics.

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$925,000.
