NATURE OF CASE

This is a recommendation to settle for \$77,500, the lawsuit filed by Plaintiff Simie Fang alleging her civil rights were violated on October 28, 2010, when she was falsely arrested and maliciously prosecuted by Los Angeles County Sheriff's Deputies.

Due to the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a reasonable settlement at this time will avoid further litigation costs. Therefore, a full and final settlement of the case in the amount of \$77,500 is recommended.
