Daniel M. Thomas served as county supervisor for one term. He assumed office in 1853.

In addition to his supervisorial seat, Thomas was also the first county judge to be elected to represent San Bernardino County. In 1854 he was re-elected as San Bernardino county judge for a four-year term. Thomas was a man of fair education but without any formal legal training. When he wasn't conducting County business, he was farming.

In 1857 Thomas resigned as county judge to return to Salt Lake City, Utah, with others from his faith.
