- 28 projects are expected to launch by the end of September 2022

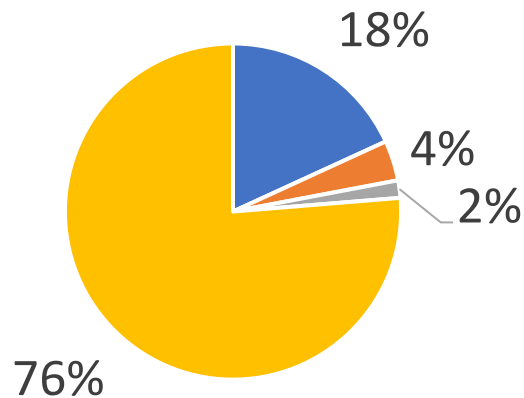
The remaining projects are expected to launch in late fall or early winter.

*(last updated 9/20/2022)*

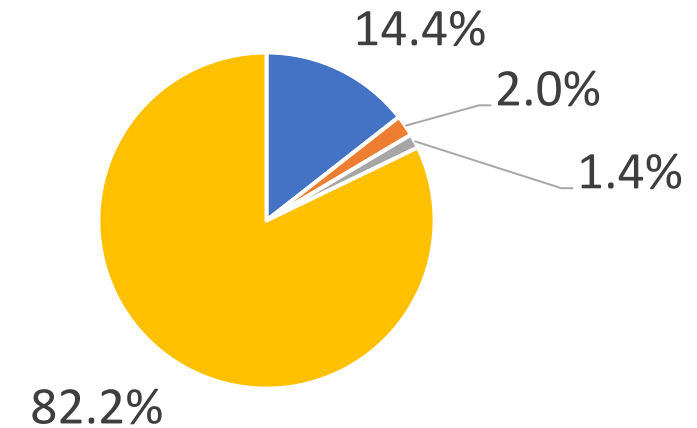
- 24% of funds for Tranche 1 projects were encumbered with approximately 18% of project funds expended

**ARPA Funds: \$17,300,00**

**Launch Date: July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022**

The Elderly Nutrition Program (ENP) supported with ARPA funds provides meals to older adults 60 years and older. The purpose of the program is to:

- Reduce hunger and food insecurity
- Promote the socialization of older individuals
- Promote the health and well-being of older individuals

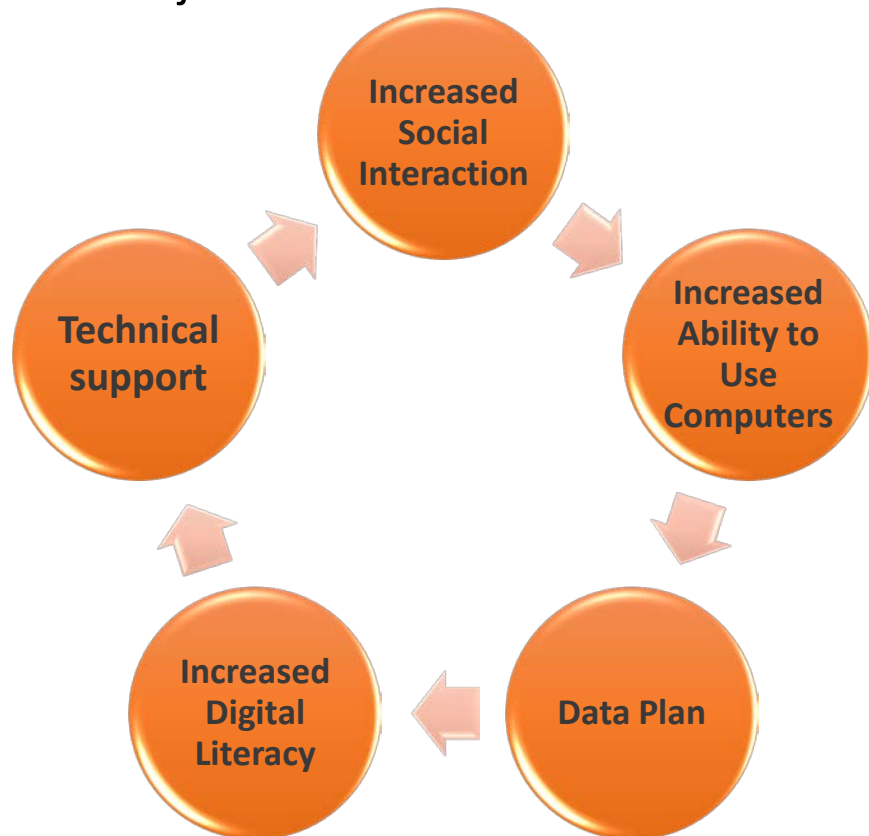
