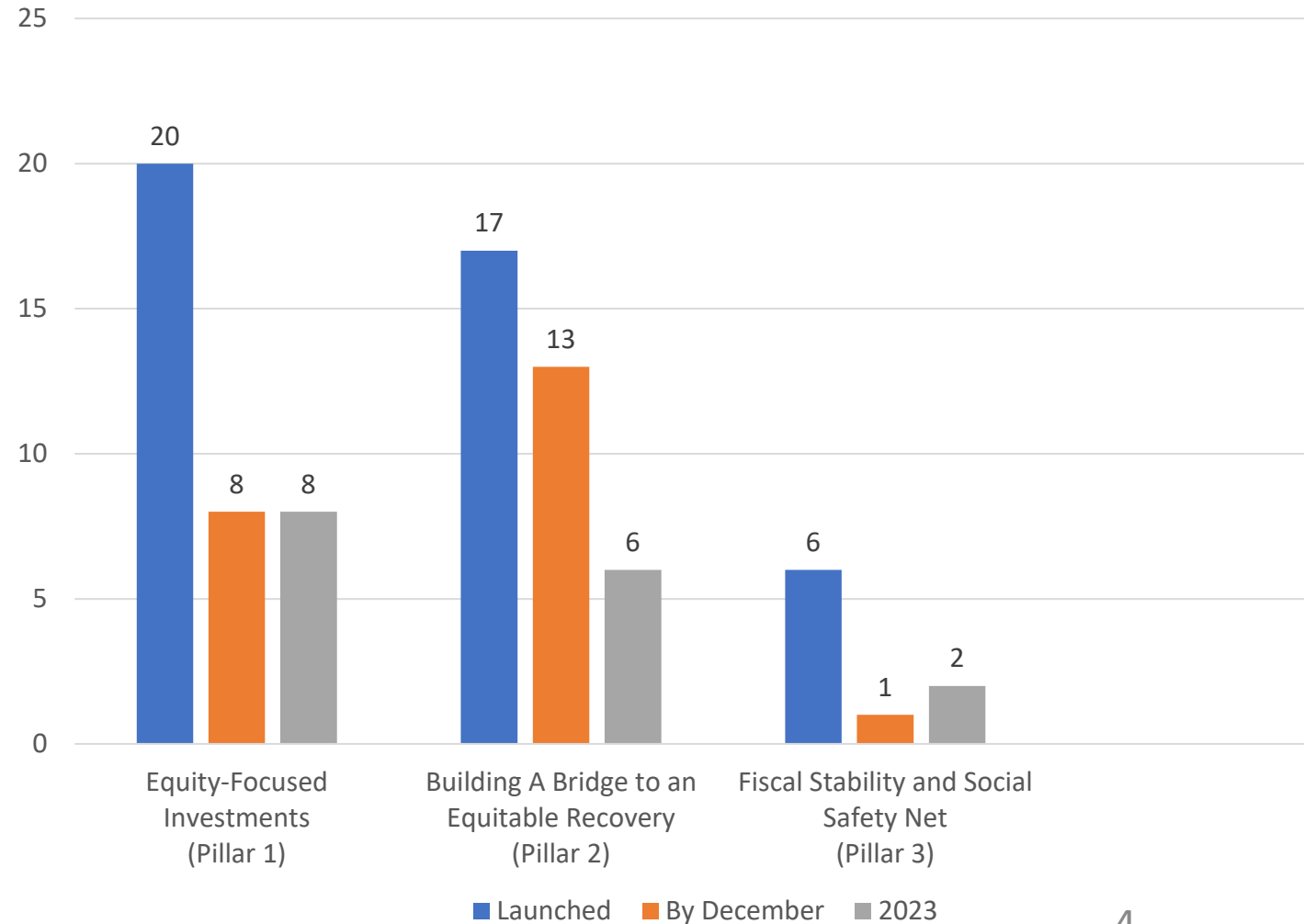

# I. ARP Program Implementation

## Overview – Launch Dates *(last updated 10/13/2022)*

Of the approved Tranche 1 projects:

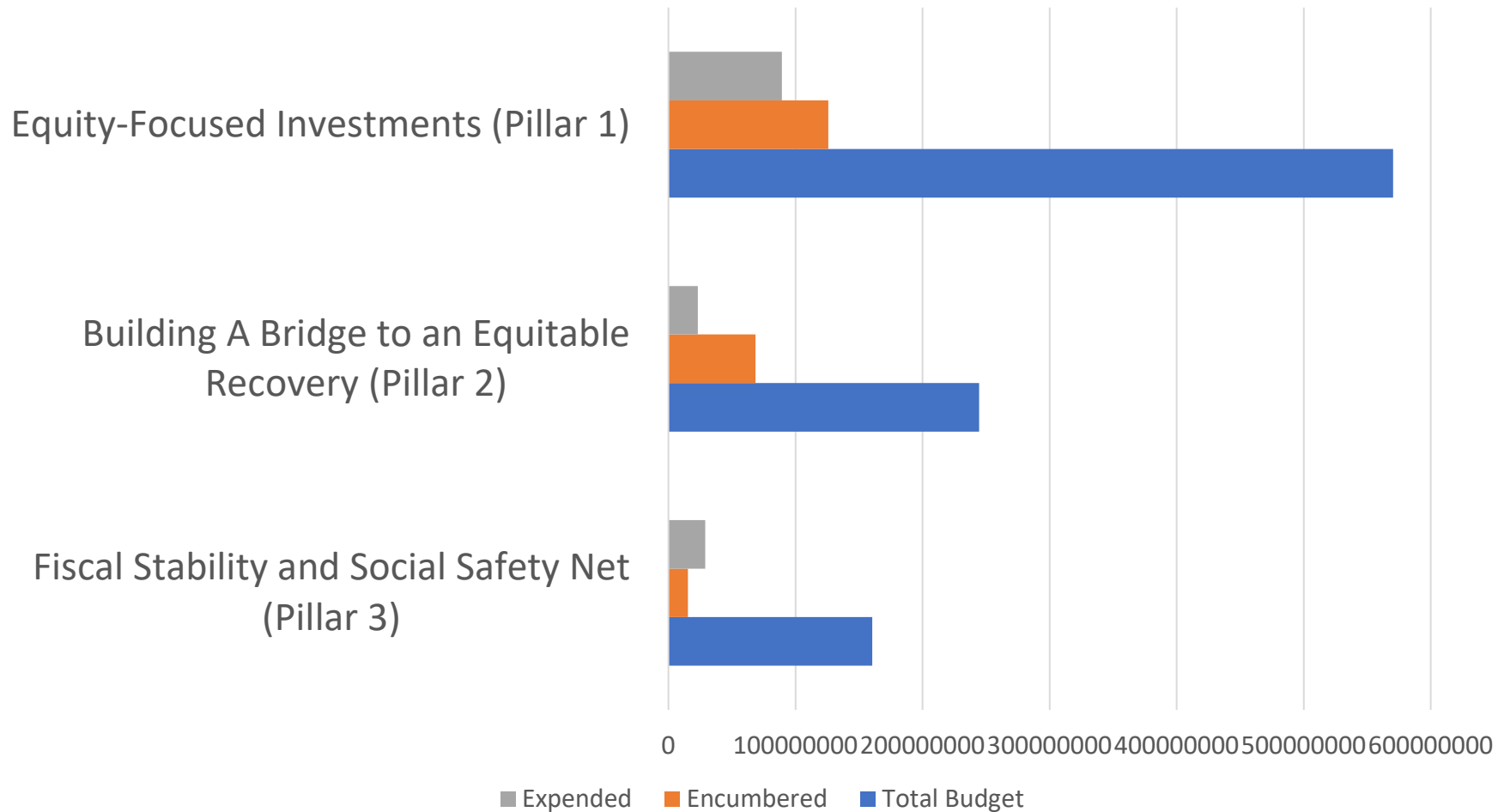
- 43 have launched.
- 22 projects are expected to launch by the end of the calendar year.
- The remaining projects are expected to launch in early 2023.



# CEO. I. ARP Program Implementation Overview

## – Spending *(last updated 10/13/2022)*

- Of the approved Tranche 1 allocations, nearly 22% of the funds were encumbered, with nearly 15% of funds expended.

## Food Assistance Awareness Campaign

- Our project aims to increase CalFresh participation in Los Angeles County by funding partnerships with CBOs and hyperlocal media outlets.
- **Target populations:** Asians, Asian Pacific Islanders, Seniors, and LGBTQ+.
- **Budget:** \$500,000 - 25 CBOs to receive a \$20,000 grant over one year.
