Leadership Table for Regional Homeless Alignment (LTRHA)

- Unites the region behind one homelessness plan
- Provides input on Measure A goal baseline and metrics
- Recommends standards of care
- Educates the community about homelessness and goal progress
- Provides input on Measure A expenditures
- Advises on progress towards Measure A goals

Executive Committee for Regional Homeless Alignment (ECRHA)

- Develop and drives one homelessness plan
- Develops Measure A goal baseline and metrics
- Develops standards of care
- Aligns funding, resources, and decisions within jurisdictions
- Makes recommendations regarding Measure A funds
- Reviews progress towards Measure A goals

Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors

- Approves one homelessness plan and adopts the regional plan required by Measure A
- Approves Measure A goal baseline and metrics
- Enacts the annual county homelessness budget
- Decides on performance-based Measure A funding changes
- Reviews Measure A accountability reports

ECRHA and the Leadership Table are Brown Act bodies created by the Board of Supervisors on August 8, 2023, to advise the Board on aligning homelessness responses and resources

The creation of goals was mandated by Measure A, but the adopted goals and metrics are not restricted to Measure A-funded efforts and are meant to guide and measure the collective efforts of all homeless programs and funding in the Los Angeles region, whether those efforts are funded by Measure A or another funding source.
