Eaton Fire

- Date started: January 7, 2025 (at 6:18 p.m. per Cal Fire records)
- Date of containment: January 31, 2025
- Acreage burned: 14,021 acres
- Structures destroyed (residential, commercial and other): 9,414
- Structures damaged: 1,074
- Confirmed fatalities: 19
- Agency with jurisdiction: LA County Fire Department

Palisades Fire

- Date started: January 7, 2025 (at 10:30 a.m. per Cal Fire)
- Date of containment: January 31, 2025
- Acreage burned: 23,448 acres
- Structures destroyed (residential, commercial and other): 6,837
- Structures damaged: 973
- Confirmed fatalities: 12
- Agency with jurisdiction: LA City Fire Department

Recovery Statistics

- Total household hazardous waste removed by the Environmental Protection Agency: +300 tons
- Total fire debris removed by the US Army Corps of Engineers: +2.6 million tons

Estimated Economic Impacts

- Economic output lost: \$5.2 billion to \$10.1 billion
- Businesses impacted: ~6,800
- Workers impacted: ~47,000
- Labor income lost: \$2.2 to \$4.2 billion
- Tax revenue losses: \$900 million to \$1.6 billion
