NARRATIVE:

Juan Arroyo is a documented gang member and has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include felon in possession of a firearm, transport and selling narcotic controlled substances, vehicular hit and run, receiving stolen property, vehicle theft, obstructing a peace officer, evading a peace officer, under influence of controlled substances, resisting a peace officer, false ID to peace officer and suspended license. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 4 year term for transporting and selling narcotic controlled substances. Arroyo was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on February 12, 2016. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in February 2018 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Arroyo qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for evading a peace officer is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history, gang member status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
